## 2010 Race Schedule

### RACING REQUIREMENTS

20" BMX style bike. Remove reflectors, chain guard, kickstand and pegs. Full face off road type helmet, a long sleeve shirt, jeans and a pair of tennis shoes or skateboard shoes. A set of BMX race pads are always recommended for safety on the handlebars, stem and frame; You can just use some foam pipe insulation w/duct or electrical tape to hold that on to get by for now. There are people at the track to help you with your bike. A few loaner helmets are available at the track.

### DRIVING DIRECTIONS

Take highway 23 through Fond du Lac to Hickory Street. If you are coming from the West turn left or from the North turn right. Go to the 300 Block, you'll see the track from there.
